

THE above illustration will give you an idea of the relative size of the O-4 and O-6 tractors. Compare these dimensions. The height of the O-4 at the radiator is 53% inches and the wheelbase is 66½ inches. For the O-6 the figures are 605% and 76 inches.

With two models to choose from you can select, according to the size of your grove or orchard, the right size of tractor for your needs. That is important, for when a tractor is too small there is always a tendency to overload it—and wear it out prematurely. Or the underpowered owner may work his tractor night and day and still never finish up on time—with consequent crop losses from inadequate preparation and cultivation. On the other hand, when a tractor is too large the owner is paying for power he doesn't need.
