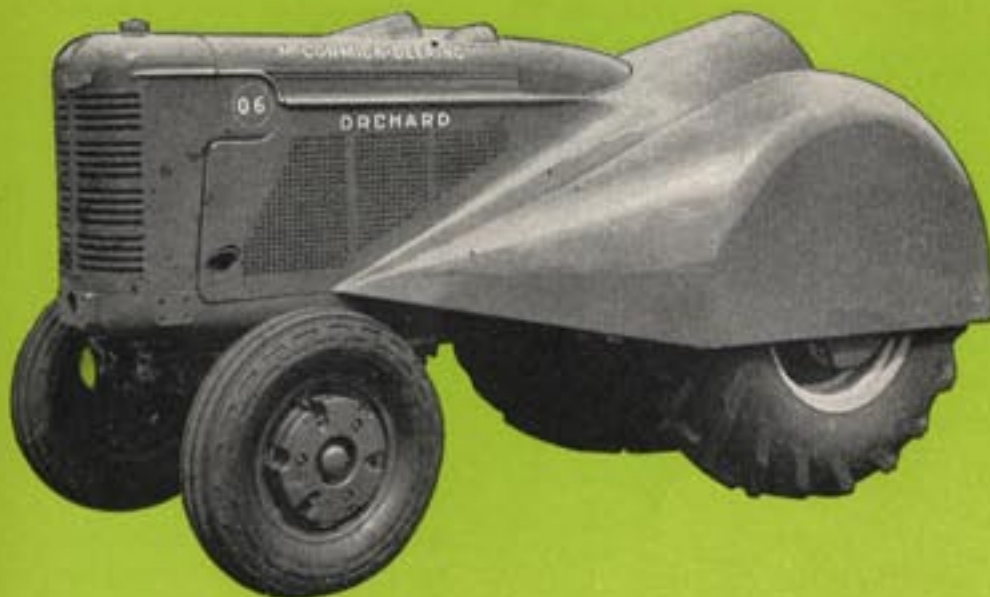
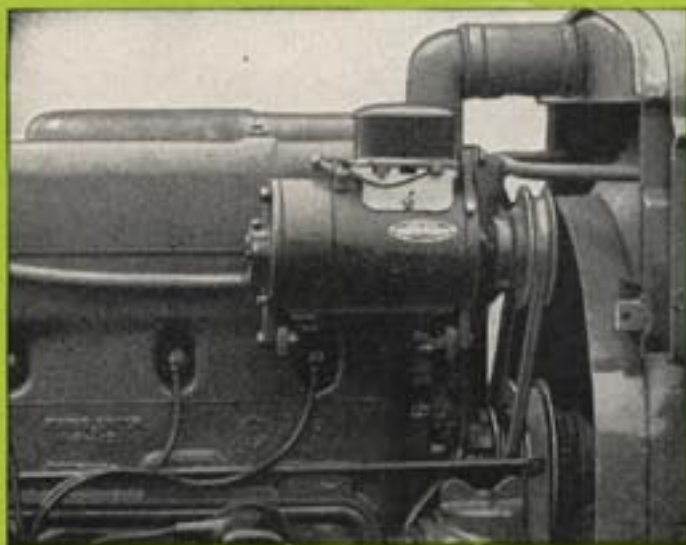


# Special Equipment

A tractor buyer doesn't want to pay for accessories he doesn't need. He wants to feel free to choose accessory equipment according to the work he intends to do, the types of machines he intends to use, and his own preferences. For that reason the following equipment for Orchard and Grove tractors is listed as "special":



Wheel weights, both front and rear, are available in various combinations to suit the requirements or preferences of owners. (Wheel weights are not needed on solid front wheels.) The steering wheel cowl, quickly detachable when not required, is also supplied only on special order. Electric light shown is also special equipment.



Showing position of the generator which is part of the automotive type electric starting and lighting equipment available on special order. Note that the generator is belt-driven from the fan shaft. The double sheave on the fan shaft is regularly supplied on all tractors as a convenience to purchasers intending to install lighting and starting equipment later.

Belt pulley,  $9\frac{3}{4}$  inches diameter,  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches face for O-4, and 11 inches diameter,  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches face for O-6; A.S.A.E. standard power take-off; electric lights, one front, one rear; electric starting (standard automotive type); wheel weights, both front and rear (not needed on solid front wheels); radiator shutter and heat indicator (for tractors not regularly so equipped); steering wheel cowl; 7 m.p.h. fourth speed in place of regular  $4\frac{7}{8}$  m.p.h.; engine-operated tire pump. (Note: special pistons for high-altitude operation, 5,000 and 8,000 feet, are optional equipment.)

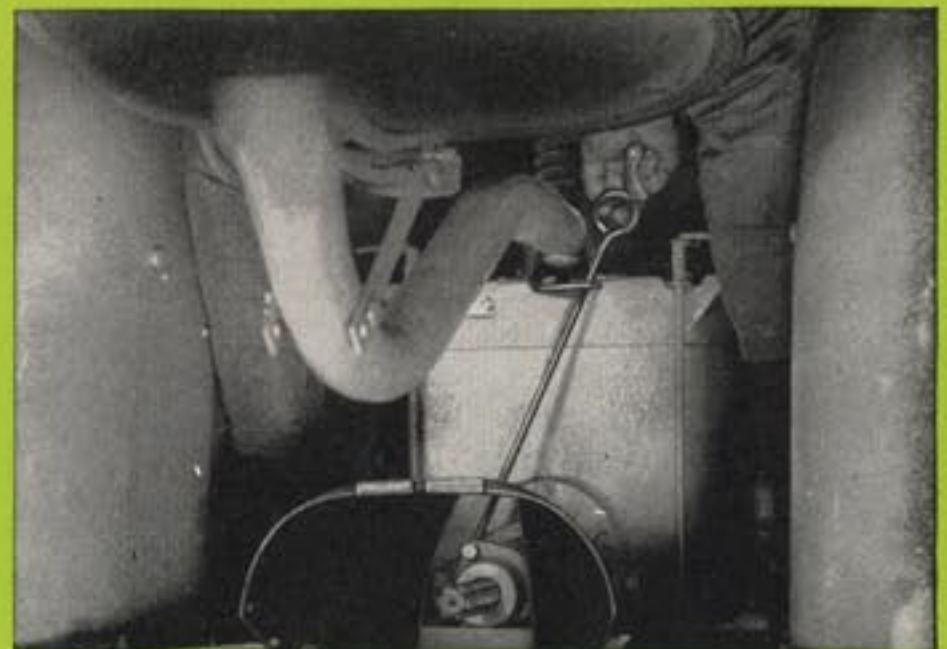

Single front and rear electric lights as shown are available as extra equipment. With strong, steady electric light the tractor can be operated day and night in rush seasons or when unfavorable weather has delayed operations past their normal time. Almost indispensable, too, for moving on the highway at night.



Rockwood belt pulleys are available for the O-4 and O-6 tractors. These pulleys assure a satisfactory drive with a minimum of slippage.



An A.S.A.E. standard power take-off, complete with protective shield, is available for use with sprayers and dusters or any other tractor-driven equipment which an orchard or grove owner might use with his tractor. As shown, the power take-off is engaged and disengaged by means of a push-pull control rod conveniently operated from the driver's seat.
