## KEEP YOUR EQUIPMENT FIT FOR THE PRODUCTION FRONT

Because of the limited manufacture of new farm equipment and also the urgent demand for maximum production of food your present farm equipment must both last longer and work with the greatest efficiency possible. Your equipment will be kept in better condition to do its utmost for the Production Front if these suggestions are followed:

1. Operate safely.  
Casualties on the food front can be as serious as on the fighting front. Operate power-driven machines with proper shields in position at all times.

2. Use each machine correctly.  
Read carefully the owner's instruction manual provided with each machine; and lubricate, adjust, and operate accordingly.

3. Check parts regularly that are subject to wear  
This is especially important at the beginning and end of each season of use. Periodic inspection should be given every machine that is used the year around. Adjustments should be made as required.

4. Keep all nuts tightened and cotter pins spread at all times.  
Do not rob one machine of bolts, fittings, etc., for emergency repairs to another without provision for immediate replacement.

5. When worn or broken parts require replacement use genuine IHC parts. This will give you exact fit and increase the life of your machine. International Harvester dealers are making every effort to carry adequate stocks of service parts and to maintain skilled servicemen for the purpose of keeping machines in the best of operating condition. As men, materials, and facilities are limited make sure that you order all parts and service work in plenty of time for the job ahead!


